The Columbus Upground Reservoir R-2 Basin is more than 843 acres. It required 37,000,000 Sq Ft of 40 mil Polypropylene fabricated geomembrane covered with 37,000,000 Sq Ft. of 10 oz non woven geotextile in the largest single lined reservoir in the USA. All of the polypropylene geomembrane field seams were dual track welded and air channel tested while the geotextile cover seams were heat sealed over the entire liner. EPI provided fabrication, installation, quality control and electronic leak location for this monumental three year project.
